

# Transfer Guide: COCC Nursing to Bushnell BSN or MSN

Prepare for the next stage in your education

Bushnell University and Central Oregon Community College have collaborated to create a streamlined pathway for new nurses to earn their BSN or MSN.

- ✓ All COCC nursing graduates who meet the requirements will be granted admission
- ✓ No specific course prerequisites
- ✓ No upper-division credits required outside the 30-credit BSN major
- ✓ Fully online BSN & MSN programs for working nurses
- ✓ CCNE-accredited

By following the worksheet below, you can complete 100% of the general education core for the bachelor's degree at COCC, minimizing your time and cost to earn your BSN or MSN.

*Note: These requirements do not have to be met prior to enrolling at Bushnell. This guide is a tool for planning purposes. The general education core requirements are alternatively fulfilled with an AAOT or a prior bachelor's degree.*

	Additional nursing courses in COCC's program count toward social science and meet the remaining credit requirement.	✓
<b>Diversity</b> At least one course addressing topics of cultural and/or ethnic diversity in society	NUR 106 meets diversity requirement.	✓
<b>Math/Science/Computer</b> One course of each, minimum 4 credits each: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Math 105 or higher</li> <li>• Science with a lab</li> <li>• Computer</li> </ul>	Math 105 can be completed at COCC or Bushnell. <i>Note: Statistics is not required.</i>	
	BI 231 meets science requirement.	✓
	A computer competency exam is available for those who wish to test out of the computer requirement.	
<b>Bible/Theology</b> 8 semester credits	This content is incorporated into the BSN major at Bushnell. No extra classes required.	✓
<b>Electives</b>	Most nurses have enough transfer credits to meet the electives requirement. A Bushnell enrollment advisor can review your transcripts to determine if any additional credits are needed. If so, they can be taken through COCC or Bushnell.

RN to MSN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• General education core</li><li>• 27-credit BSN curriculum</li><li>• 30 or 36-credit MSN curriculum</li></ul>	Bachelor of science in nursing <i>and</i> Master of science in nursing	2 ½ years (full-time), Just over 3 years (part-time)
RN to MSN Bridge	<p><i>For nurses who hold a bachelor's degree in a non-nursing field. The general education core is already met.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 15 credits of BSN curriculum</li><li>• 30 or 36-credit MSN curriculum</li></ul>	Master of science in nursing	2 years plus 1 semester, depending on chosen MSN concentration
