








## How Completers Rate NCU's Program Compared to Statewide Alumni from All Oregon Universities



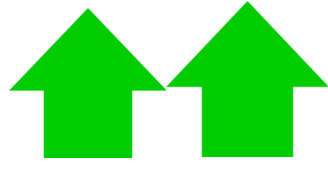

**Completer Response Rate:** 39.22% of completers at NCU responded (n=20), compared with 33.86% for Oregon completers.
