

Transfer Guide: LBCC Nursing to Bushnell BSN or MSN

Prepare for the next stage in your education

Bushnell University and Linn-Benton Community College have collaborated to create a streamlined pathway for new nurses to earn their BSN or MSN. By following the worksheet below, **you can complete 100% of the general education core for the bachelor's degree at LBCC**, minimizing your time and cost to earn your next degree.

- ✓ All LBCC nursing graduates who meet the requirements will be granted admission
- ✓ No upper-division credits required outside the 30-credit BSN major
- ✓ CCNE-accredited, fully online BSN & MSN programs for working nurses
- ✓ Free, no-obligation transfer evaluation for prospective students

Note: It is not required for these classes to be completed prior to enrolling at Bushnell; gen. ed. courses can be taken at Bushnell concurrently with the BSN if you wish. This guide is a tool for planning purposes if you'd like to complete the gen. ed. requirements ahead of time at LBCC.
