## Phase 1: Academic Performance & Professional Experience

Once applications are received and determined to be complete and qualified, they will be reviewed by the admissions department and scored according to the following rubric:

One score will be assigned for each requirement: general biology, microbiology, and anatomy & physiology. Where multiple classes satisfy one requirement, the average grade will be used. 12 points maximum.

## Phase 2: Essays & Other Qualifications

Essays will be scored based on how well applicants address and discuss the identified points in the essay questions and illustrate the applicant's leadership abilities, academic capabilities, life, work, volunteer, healthcare, or other experiences, compassion/respect for all people, passion for nursing, and faith journey. Additional experiences, skills, licenses/certifications, education, and other qualifications will also be reviewed and considered.
